## RED LIGHT RUNNER BEWARE!

Captain Margaret Young from the Killeen Police Department was our guest speaker at our July 14th club meeting. Captain Young is the first female Captain of the Killeen police force. She is currently Patrol Division Commander. She spoke to the club



regarding the red light cameras that had been installed at busy intersections throughout the city of Killeen. During the May pilot period there were over 7,000 incidents recorded of people who had run a red light. Those people were sent a letter notifying them that the cameras were in place and that they had violated a red light traffic device. After the May pilot period the cameras recorded 8,000 June running red-light violations. Each of these individuals sent a citation for running the red lights at the five intersections with cameras.

The city installed the cameras to help increase driver awareness at selected intersections that had recorded a high number of violations and/or accidents.

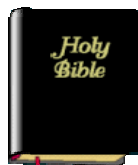
