DUTIES OF A CONSTABLE

By popular request, former (an soon to be new) club member Edd Melton, III was our guest speaker at our July 21st club meeting. Edd gave the club an outlook on what the duties and responsibilities are for a constable and told the club members present that constables in Texas have multi-jurisdictional authority for law enforcement. The constable's main job is to fulfill civil court orders as prescribed by the judge. He advised that his job is not hard, but it is not easy either since he is



required to evict people. He stated that people are given due process and many times those they evict are repeat offenders who have learned how to use the system. He also stated that many times the landlord requests eviction because criminal activity is taking place on their property.

By command of Article 2.13 Code of Criminal Procedure, it is the duty of every peace officer to: preserve the peace within the officer's jurisdiction by all lawful means; interfere without warrant to prevent or suppress crime where authorized by the Code of Criminal Procedure; execute all lawful criminal process issued to the officer by any magistrate or court; give notice to some magistrate of all offenses committed (See Constable Pg 2)

within the officer's jurisdiction, where the officer has good reason to believe there has been a violation of the penal law; arrest offenders without warrant in every case where the officer is authorized by law, in order that they may be taken before the proper magistrate or court to be tried.

Consequently, to keep the peace, the constable in Texas may perform patrol, enforce traffic regulations, undertake investigations, arrest law breakers, carry out executions of judgment, summons persons to aid him in his duties when necessary, and to complete juries. He may seize, impound, and sell real and personal property as directed by law.
