Important reasons to preplan your service: Financial concerns: Many decisions about services and purchases may have to be made during a time of intense emotional stress. Making these decisions ahead of time allows for more careful consideration of all the options in choosing the funeral that is right for you and your family. Emotional concerns: Some people want to ease the stress that their loved ones are likely to experience during the time of planning a funeral. Making your wishes known in advance will reduce the number of decisions that your loved ones will have to make and may help make this time of loss less stressful.
