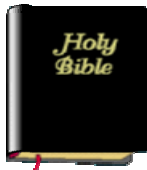

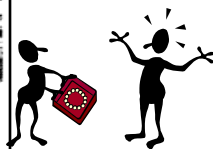
LACE Listening Lab
