Prepared to Shelter

Brett Williams, Killeen Parks and Recreation Director attended our July 2nd club meeting. Mr. Williams discussed the city's ongoing efforts to be prepared for disaster. The city was able to respond to the human needs after Hurricanes Katrina and Rita, but soon realized that the magnitude of the needs could exceed the community's ability to serve. The entire community center was used as a shelter and the special events center was used to process donations of food and clothing. Killeen was one of the only city's that was ready to respond and that also received 100 percent reimbursement for expenses from FEMA.

Mr. Williams advised that the community center has been put into use several times this year to shelter those who have been displaced by flooding. Parks and Recreation staff works closely with Chad Berg, the Emergency Management Director to make sure the city remains ready in the future and disaster planning continues.

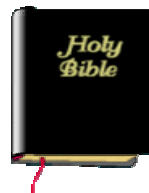
