Members of the Exchange Club of Killeen hosted Linda Walker from the Family Advocacy Center from Fort Hood. Ms. Walker gave a thorough presentation on the dangers of Shaking a Baby. She brought handouts and a babydoll to demonstrate the kind of shaking she was talking about. She advised that males make up 70% of shakers and most of those are the child's biological fathers. Others who shake are mothers, and child care givers. Her position is one of 20 throughout the Army in a pilot program to help eliminate this problem.
