Mr Van Valkenburgh presented a brief overview of Killeen Department of Aviation operations which includes Killeen-Fort Hood Regional Airport and Skylark Field. He stated that during the period of 2007—2010 enplanements and revenues were increasing, however there were a slight downward trend during the period of 2010– 2012 but planning and development continued. Presently, 2013 shows an increase in enplanements and revenues are up and planning along with development for the future continues to be a priority. Projects ongoing are: terminal expansion, hold rooms, TSA offices, new checked baggage inspection system, meter/greeter patios, and upgraded security systems. Additionally, the retail area upgrade will provide additional opportunities for retail sales. Three major Airlines provide a total of 14 daily flights in and out of Killeen with service to Dallas, Houston, and Atlanta, GA.

Aviation continued-

Negotiations are currently ongoing with other major airlines services to our area. Skylark Field provides the need for private and corporate aviation access as our economy grows. Revenues are stable and planning, designing, and some hangers constructions have been completed.

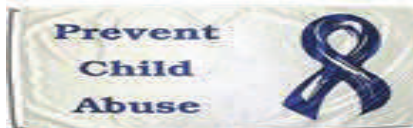
